

Indonesian – English Language for Kids

Explain Everything

Introduce the Topic

We start with a whole class exploration of the Indonesian language. An app like <u>Learn Indonesian with Babbel</u> provides some simple visual prompts for common phrases. Using the Indoesian – English Language for Kids app, students note objects



that they will be able to find in Minecraft, such as physical landforms and house objects.



Build Understanding

Now in Minecraft, when students find one of the objects for which they have just explored the Indonesian translation, they speak it in the game and take a screenshot.



Apply Learning

Using Explain Everything, students can combine their Minecraft screenshot with a screenshot from the Indonesian – English Language for Kids app to show a visual translation. Students can also record themselves narrating the translations, creating their



own interactive tutorial for teaching others the translated word and object links.
